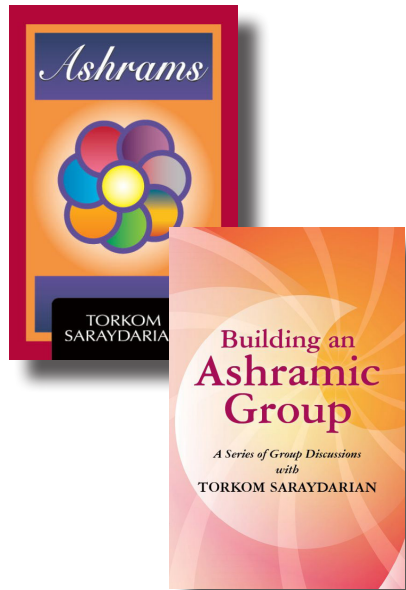

The term “Ashram” is defined in Sanskrit as a hermitage or retreat where a person goes to meet himself. Another definition is a place where ascetics live to try and detach themselves from physical, emotional, and mental attachments. The term “ascetic” refers to one who is really trying to detach himself. Going to an Ashram for this purpose is a very important step in our evolution. As we strive toward spirit, toward light, and toward the achievement of our Inner Self, we must begin to detach ourselves.

The sphere of light, or Ashram, with which an individual is connected is like a major radio station to which millions of radios are tuned. The radios are nourished by it, and they nourish it. It is a sphere of consciousness to which each individual contributes and receives.
