Reader: Gita

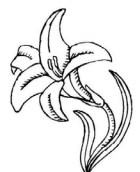
Truly,

Readings: Steps to Resurrection

Adapted from *Teachings of Christ*, Vol. 4, (Ch. 11)

Reader: Stan

There is no resurrection, freedom, or release unless a person starts working for the good of others.

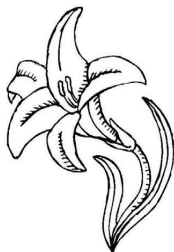
How much time are we really giving to do good for others without expectation? This first step puts us on the path of resurrection.

Living a life that is harmless in thought, emotions, speech, and action helps to free us. All Resurrected Ones advise us that no one can enter into the path of resurrection until he lives a harmless life. A harmless life does not create cause and effect, or karma. Unless one breaks his karma, the causes of his transgressions, he cannot enter the light of resurrection.

Harmlessness is a must.

You are going to take some time and consider, “How harmful am I? How can I become less harmful? What can I do to be really harmless in my thinking, in my feeling, and in my words and actions?”

(Let us say the following prayer together)



O Giver of Light,
the Cosmic Beauty,
permeate my whole nature
with Thy Rays.
Kindle the flame
on the altar of my temple
so that I may live
as a beam of Light,

Another step to achieve resurrection is in Cooperation with the Common Good. Are we cooperating with all those activities and movements that sincerely, without hypocrisy or self-interest, sacrifice and dedicate themselves to the Common Good of humanity — for the animal kingdom, for the vegetable kingdom, for the whole Mother Earth? To what degree are we dedicated to them, and how much do you contribute your time, energy, and money to work for the Common Good of humanity?

(Let us say the following prayer together)



O sphere of Light,
advancing and elevating Goodness,
May my soul rise with You,
expressing goodness in all its contacts.

Another step to achieve resurrection is in making humanity the axis of our interests. One of our adventures will be, “Who, where, and what are people doing to help humanity help this planet? Can I help in some way?”

There are great geniuses, great artists, great philosophers, great creative people who need help to bring transformation to this planet. Are we helping them, or are we involved in our personality gains and losses, hatreds and fears, slanders and malice, and personal, petty interests? Does our whole life turn around our personality axis? We can change this and take a step on the path of resurrection by making humanity the axis of our interests.

(Let us say the following prayer together)



The Flame of the Great Presence in me,
let me stand as a radiant Fire of righteousness,
today and during the days of my life.
Let me think, act, and speak
in the spirit of righteousness.

As you enter the path of resurrection, things become more difficult and challenging. Greater responsibilities come to you, but greater wisdom, courage, and daring also come to you. The second phase of resurrection starts with meditation.

If you can exist one minute without ego, it will be your first experience of paradise. Lord Buddha, in speaking about other Buddhas, said, “Those Who achieved are Those Who left Their egos centuries ago.”

Start doing meditation daily. Meditate for two, three, four minutes. Wash yourself, sit in meditation, and try to resurrect your mind and soul out of your problems, sicknesses, complications, hindrances, slander, and malice. Let this whole mess quiet down while you surpass it by meditating about your infinite light, infinite life, and infinite future.

Then practice Contemplation. Scientifically, contemplation is the fusion of your individualized mind with the mind of the planet and with the Cosmos. Meditation is focus; contemplation is fusion. Contemplation is a very advanced stage.

Have a moment of contemplation. Admire Nature, the trees, waterfalls, sky, and stars — God. Do this for just one minute and see what happens to you. One minute of contemplation cures ten million diseases. This is where the miracle happens.

A miracle is the process of withdrawing yourself out of your lower vehicles and fusing with the Spirit of Divine Energy.

My Lord,
thank You for the joy of living today
in the spirit of beauty, goodness, and righteousness.
May Your joy radiate in other parts of the world,
as the Sun disperses the night
and brings the joy of the day.

Then we have the practice of Renunciation. After meditation and contemplation, you are now becoming enlightened, and you start a process of detachment in your life. From what are you detaching? How and when are you going to create detachment? Of course, the first step will be to detach from physical objects, then from your emotional attachments and hang-ups, and then from mental darkness and conflicts, storms and agitations. You renounce them. After this, you must continue by renouncing any particles of ego that still remain within you. Renounce separatism.

Once the intelligent forces of Nature see that you are resurrecting yourself, you are promoted to higher positions and higher responsibilities so that you work more efficiently for the Common Good.

(Let us say the following prayer together)



My Lord,
let Your freedom permeate my whole being.
Let me be free from all worries and anxieties,
from all painful memories of the day,
from all attachments and identifications,
so that my soul freely soars
in Your Temple of Beauty.
Let me realize freedom from my
physical, emotional, and mental crystallizations
and be with You as a free soul.

Sacrifice. Focus, meditate, fuse, contemplate, renounce, detach — then sacrifice. Sacrifice is radiation. Your Light becomes radioactive. At this point, nothing hinders your Light. Your past misdeeds, wrongdoings, failures, and so on do not matter. They melt away when the Inner Sun starts radiating out, creating total purification of the energy in your aura and in the auras of others with whom you are related.

Compassion. You become a Compassionate One. It is said that every Resurrected One is a Master of Compassion. Compassion is all-inclusiveness holism.

Seven Step Meditation on the Virtue of Compassion

Excerpted from *Virtues & Values* by Torkom Saraydarian

1. Aspiration: Lift your heart toward the virtue of **compassion**
2. Concentration: Observe where in your life you can express this virtue.
3. Meditation: Find the deeper meaning of this virtue. What does it mean to you? Think in physical, emotional, mental, and spiritual terms.
4. Discipline: Choose one part of your life — such as how you treat yourself, your family relations, or one specific area — and visualize expressing this virtue toward that person or that area of life.
5. Contemplate: Go deeper into silence. Ask your Solar Angel (Guardian Angel): “Reveal to me a greater vision of this virtue of **compassion**. Where else can I find expressions of this virtue?” Wait for the answer to come to you now, or observe how it may unfold much later.
6. Illumination: Go deeper. Ask: What is a very subtle way that you can use this **compassion** in your life?
7. Inspiration: Visualize standing on top of a mountain. See beautiful vegetation, flowers all around you. Feel the breeze of pure air on your face. Breathe deeply. Observe the expressions of **compassion** that God and all of Nature have manifested all around you. Breathe it in. Visualize your whole nature, your whole body, radiating the virtue. Breathe in the virtue. Breathe out the virtue. What does that look like? What does that feel like? What color is it? What is its musical rhythm? Can you find it?

With eyes closed, visualize sitting quietly on a rock on top of the mountain, and relax, radiating your sacrificial nature toward all life. See little animals looking at you and really observe them. Observe deeply all the life around you. Be grateful and full of joy.

Say OM three times, quietly, unifying your sound with the sound of Nature.

It is time for us to practice a New Age Communion Service, one in which we become one with Christ in our hearts and souls.

New Communion — See The Master

Excerpted from *Self Image, Finding your True Identity* by Torkom Saraydarian

1. Remain sitting in calmness and joy.
2. In calmness imagine above your head a sphere of light. Imagine a sphere of light and in that light, in the center of that light, visualize the Christ
3. When you imagine that image, see a white halo around His head. That is the head center.
4. Then see a fiery sphere around His throat; it is a yellow center of light or fire.
5. Then see a disc of light near His heart, a blue light.
6. Imagine yourself sitting in front of Him and see that His head center is mixing with your head center, purifying all your thinking, your mind.
7. Now imagine His throat center expanding and taking your throat center inside of itself.
8. Now imagine His heart center, and His heart center is fusing with your heart center.
9. You are seeing around your head **clear, pure light**; around your throat a wonderful **lemon yellow**; and in your heart imagine a **blue light**.
10. Now slowly see that Christ is rising up, rising up and coming close to your head center and slowly descending into you, and you are becoming one with the Master you were visualizing.
11. Now feel His presence, especially in your head, in your throat center, into your heart center. Feel that you are charged with Him. That is the secret or foundation of Holy Communion. You become one with Christ.

Repeat after Gita:

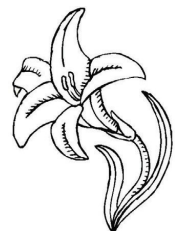
My Lord,

May Christ return to Earth.

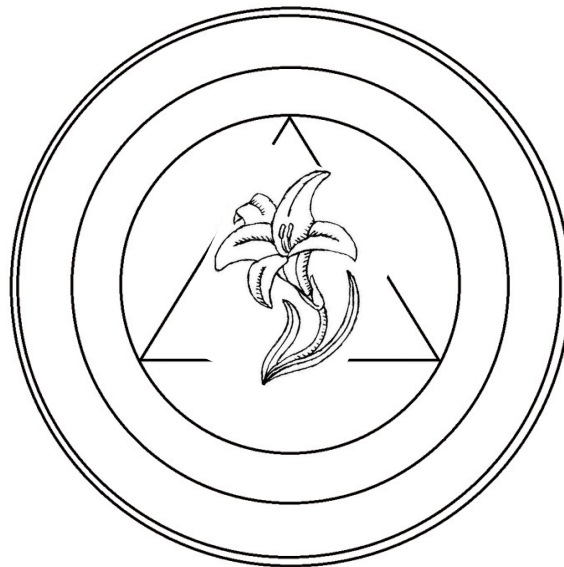
From the center where the Will of God is known

And may it seal the door where evil dwells.

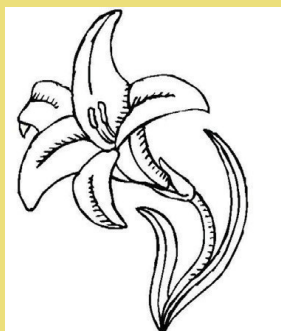
Let Light and Love and Power restore the Plan on Earth
